A Brief History

Jo Ann Hollway is the founder and director of Ramiah Ministries. She began the ministry in 1971 by teaching children and collecting clothing for those in need. She began leading ladies' Bible studies, and started Adult Foster Care in 1983, started the writing ministry in 1988, and founded the prison ministry in 1990. The ministry received the Hebrew name "Ramiah" in 1991 and its tax-exempt status in 1997. A large staff of volunteers helps with the ministry, and a prayer letter is distributed several times a year.

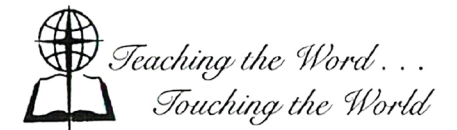
About the Founder

Jo Ann has earned an Associate in Science Degree and a Bachelor of Science in Bible Degree. She has completed courses in Pastoral Counseling and in Marriage and Family. She is a former member of VCCNJ (Volunteers in Courts and Corrections of NJ), having completed training workshops (for working with inmates) at the Annual Training Institute at Hughes Justice Center, Trenton, NJ. She has also completed pre-nursing, American Red Cross, and professional business courses.



Jo Ann is certified by the Departments of Health and Community Affairs of New Jersey for the completion of the Residential Care Operator's Training Program.

Her background includes writing lyrics to many gospel songs in the late '70s, with Dr. David Schleip writing most of the music. A CD with Jo Ann's testimony, that aired on WKDN Family Radio station's "Unshackled" program, is available upon request.

❖ NURSING HOME MINISTRY

Seniors are visited and special ministry programs are presented to encourage them through God's Word.

❖ MUSIC MINISTRY

Songs have been written and are published for the glory of the Lord.

❖ GRANDPALS

Children and adults volunteer their time to visit our elderly.

❖ SHARING THE GOSPEL THROUGH TOYS MINISTRY

Toys, bikes, and Paula's Pockets are collected year-round and distributed at Christmas (with a booklet explaining salvation) to needy children and teens.

Bible courses are distributed for ages 5 through adult. Certificates are awarded upon completion.

Handmade baby and children's clothing items are made and donated for the needy.

❖ KIDETS AND CHAMPIONS FOR CHRIST

Children ages 5-12 learn Godly character qualities and how to know and live for Christ.

❖ RAMIAH'S STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP FUND FOR CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

A monetary gift is given to a college senior whose life's work will be in full time ministry.

❖ TEACHING and COUNSELING

The teaching ministry reaches women through weekly Bible studies, seminar work, and speaking engagements in various fundamental Bible-teaching churches. Some topics covered are "Putting Priorities in Order," "How to Train Our Emotions," "Building Godly Character," and "Coping with Grief and Depression."

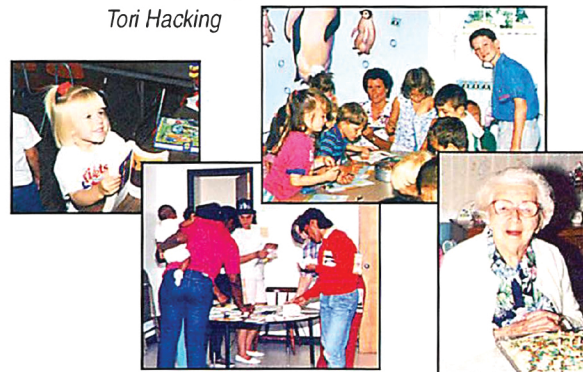

❖ CHILDREN and TEENS

The Gospel is shared through Bible stories, songs, object lessons, flannel graph lessons, Gospel illusions, and puppets. Several hundred boys and girls have come to Christ in Christian camps, VBS, and Sunday School programs. Children have been ministered to in hospitals, in nursing homes, at county fairs, church groups, and in home visits. Counseling is also available for children and teens.

Aunt Jo Ann was teaching us a Bible story. At the end of her lesson, she gave the salvation message. She asked the kids if they had any questions about salvation or wanted to get saved. I raised my hand for salvation. So she took me aside and asked me questions about why I wanted to get saved and what I believed. I answered her and then we prayed together. ❖ ADULT FOSTER CARE MINISTRY

We offer loving professional care for the elderly in Ramiah's home. This service includes the following; meals, comfortable room, television activities, and telephone. Personal, emotional, Spiritual care is an ongoing part of this personal service.

Respite Service is available for families and caregivers needing a break or time away. You may leave your loved one at the home of Ramiah for as many days per week as may be necessary. This service is offered to provide loving care, help, encouragement, a change of environment, and extra companionship for your elderly loved one. The respite service is subject to availability. Continuous respite care must be no longer than 3 months.

I am grateful for the opportunity to write these personal words for my friend, Jo Ann Hollway. It was my privilege to serve as her pastor for seven years at Fellowship Baptist Church. Because of my appreciation for both her work and witness for Christ, my own dear mother has been in the Adult Foster Care of Ramiah Ministries for over three years.
