## Let Us Praise the Lord Together for...

- 3 children prayed to receive Christ in May (making a total of 6 this year) at the after-school Good News Club at Berlin Community School
- New Bible Club at Berlin Community School is being planned for the fall
- 27 prayed to receive Christ through the inner-city outreach in Camden and the "Bread of Life" food pantry
- Approximately 150 Bibles were donated to the ministry
- Ramiah Ministries, Inc., sacred Facebook page has approximately 12,500 likes and followers. People are receiving and sharing the Gospel through this social media outlet. In the last month alone more than 38,000 read the Gospel. Pray for souls to be reached
- Approximately 3½ tons of clothing were collected and distributed

- Approximately 400 lbs. of literature were sent out to African countries

- Approximately 300 lbs. of literature is prepared to be sent to Asian countries

## From World Missionary Press...

In Ghana, Maxwell asked himself the question, "Is getting saved all there is?" His answer was that Christians need to seek first the kingdom of God. He explains, "Scripture says Jesus went about doing good. That is one of my favorite Scriptures; so anywhere I am, I spread the gospel. In the bank, if I get the opportunity, I do it. In the taxi. Sometimes I am home and I'm like, "Okay, let's go for a walk." It's just because I need to talk to somebody about Christ. Before I step out, I ask God to guide and uphold me to do [His] pleasure and glorify [Him]. That is how I live (sic).

Currently, we have helped to send out the Gospel to laypersons, missionaries, and pastors in 24 countries through World Missionary Press. Ramiah has access to Gospel booklets in 350 languages.

We continue to send requested materials to inmates across the country. We also always address (if unsure) their need for salvation as we share the Gospel
